EVERGREEN PLANS A NEW FACILITY IN SO. CA.

Irvine CA, June 19, 2008

Evergreen Oil, Inc. one of the largest waste oil collectors in the State of California announced today plans to establish a used oil processing facility in the Imperial Valley area of Southern California. The company owns and operates in Northern California the only fully permitted used oil re-refining plant in the US; which is in the final stages of an expansion to be commissioned by the first quarter of next year almost doubling its present production capacity of re-refined base lube oil.

“Our company’s success has been based on our strong commitment to the protection of the environment, and the dedicated attention to our costumers” said Gary Colbert, Evergreen’s newly appointed President/COO. “With the increasing demand for more affordable environmental lubricating oils, the Southern California new facility will allow us to better service all our customers with product availability and logistics” added Mr. Colbert.

Evergreen will announce additional details of their planned Southern California facility at a later date, as they continue working the site selection and the plant’s basic engineering design with their affiliate Chemical Engineering Partners.

The State of California recognizes “Closed Loop Recycling” (re-refining) of used oil as the *highest and best use* of the resource. This is especially so given the strategic, non-renewable nature of the resource, and the fact that used oil, when hydrotreated, can be indefinitely recycled to the same standards as virgin oil thereby conserving the resource, reducing our dependence on foreign oil, and lessening the potential for environmental pollution.

Evergreen’s state of the art new plant will utilize the same environment-friendly technology now used at its Newark facility that includes hydro-treatment to produce a high-quality, pure, colorless & odorless neutral base oil, from used engine oil; consuming only about one half of the energy needed for making it from crude oil, with a smaller carbon footprint as a result of it’s true re-refining process.

In addition to its re-refined oil products, Evergreen is recognized as a major provider of hazardous waste collection services offering customers across the State a full range of environmental services and products to handle all of their waste management needs.
